💰 **\$200/ Election Day if a required pre-election class is attended**

💰 **\$100/ Election Day if a required class is NOT attended**

To become a certified Election Commissioner, you must:

- Be a US citizen
- Be a resident of St. Tammany Parish
- Pre-register, attend a certification class, and pass the open book test

Once certified:

- You may be chosen to work as either an Assigned Commissioner or as an Alternate Commissioner on Election Day
- You will be notified, by mail or email, from the Election's team at the Clerk of Court's office

Should a pre-election class be required:

- Your attendance and participation will ensure that you are ready to go on Election Day

Work on Election Day will begin at:

- 6:30 a.m. for Saturday General Elections
- 5:30 a.m. for Tuesday Federal Elections
- All elections close at 8:00 p.m. or after the last person in line before 8:00 p.m. has voted
